INTRODUCTION | CORE PILLARS OF LEADERSHIP

Engaged, effective ASC leaders are more likely to create a purpose-driven culture that involves all team members in supporting and achieving the strategic goals of the organization. For an ASC, these must include patient safety and profitability. This session will introduce the core pillars of leadership: Purpose, Emotional Intelligence and Communication as the foundation for the conference.

KEYNOTE | PASSIONATE LEADERSHIP: SOARING TO NEW HEIGHTS

Today's leaders are challenged like never before. At the same time, they are in a unique position to have a greater impact on the future of their industry. So how can you stay inspired and continue to grow and evolve as a leader when chaos reigns, morale is low and change is a constant? EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE AND THE TRANSFORMATIVE LEADER

RISK ASSESSMENT FOR INFECTION PREVENTION IN AN ASC

A ranking system will be described to assist in prioritizing infection risks used in the development of an infection control program and QAPI projects at your facility. How outcomes are developed and measured and how to use this information for internal benchmarking will also be discussed.
